## **COVID Statement**

By taking part in the event covered by this notice of race, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that they are responsible for complying with any regulations in force from time to time in respect of COVID-19 and for complying with Bough Beech SC's COVID-19 procedures. Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official.

### **1. Cancellation:**

1.1. The Organising Authority may cancel the event, cancel classes and reject or cancel entries in its absolute discretion, subject to RRS 76.

### **2. Rules:**

2.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021 - 2024, this Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SIs).

2.2. In the event of any conflict between these Rules, those of Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

2.3 The exoneration penalty (and the advisory and RYA Arbitration) of the RYA Rules disputes procedures will be available.

2.4 RRS 29.2; RRS 35; RRS 40.2; RRS 60.1(a); RRS 64.2; RRS A4. RRS A5; A9(a); Race signals ICF "L" will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

### **3. Safety Regulations.**

**3.1 Adequate personal buoyancy must be worn by all persons at all times when afloat and on the pontoon jetty, except briefly while adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This changes RRS Rule 40 and the preamble to Part 4, and BBSC Club Byelaw E8.**

**Buoyancy must be appropriate to the size and weight of the individual and the activity in which they are engaged and must be worn in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines. It is the responsibility of each individual, or in the case of a child, their parent, guardian or support person to ensure this.**

3.2 Competitors shall wear wetsuits or dry suits at all times. Neither wetsuits nor dry suits will be considered adequate buoyancy.

### **4. Eligibility & Entry.**

4.1 Boats may only be entered by members of Bough Beech SC

4.2 Competitors **must** register for this series by completing a Web Collect entry form on the club website which is at the bottom of the Sailing/Club Racing page. [Club Racing – Bough Beech Sailing Club \(boughbeechsc.org.uk\)](https://www.boughbeechsc.org.uk). Further guidance is given in the Additional Information at the end of this notice. There will be no signing on sheets at the club.

4.3 The series are open to all classes of centre-board mono-hull sailing dinghies (but NOT foil craft) whose overall length does not exceed 20 feet or 6.096 metres.

4.4 Substitution of helm after commencement of the series will require a separate entry for that boat and will only be considered following written application to the race committee of the day.

### **5. Schedule.**

5.1 A briefing will be held at 1015 hrs at the discretion of Race Officers

5.3 Times of races

January 3rd & each Sunday thereafter up to & including Sunday 28 <sup>th</sup> February 2021	All conventional boats inc. Feva and Feva xl	Two, (weather permitting) Warning signals 10.55 and following on from the first race
January 3rd & each Sunday thereafter up to & including Sunday 28 <sup>th</sup> February 2021	All asymmetric rig boats except RSFeva and FevaXL	Two, (weather permitting) Warning signals 11.00 hrs and following on from the first race

**6. Sailing instructions.**

6.1 The sailing Instructions for this event will be the Standard Club Sailing Instructions 2021/24 which will be available on the club website.

6.2 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will also be posted on the club website

**7. The Courses.**

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be defined in the sailing instructions and displayed at the club.

**8. Scoring.**

8.1 The Scoring system is as follows; World Sailing Low Points Scoring Systems as in RRS Appendix A4 and long series Appendix A9

8.2 A minimum of four races are required to be completed to constitute the series.

8.3 The number of races a boat may exclude from her score (or the number of races to count) will depend upon the number of races completed as follows;

**9. Radio Communications.**

9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**10. Prizes.**

10.1 The Bough Beech Organising Committee will award prizes at its discretion for each of the classes racing

## **11. Advertising.**

11.1 .Boats may display advertising supplied by the organising authority.

## **12. Risk Statement**

12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.** The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **13. Insurance.**

13.1 It is a condition of entry that each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a level of cover adequate to cover all third party claims.

## **14. Rights and Copyright**

14.1 By participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during this long series event and of all of his/her material related to the championship, without compensation.

## **15. Data Protection**

15.1 In order to manage the events, information provided by competitors will be held on a database. ## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.**

### **Covid-19**

All participants are asked to familiarise themselves with the Club's Covid-19 Risk Assess for the Icicle that is posted on the club website (<http://www.boughbeechsc.org.uk/coronavirus-precautions>) and follow the rules described there. In particular, to enable the Club to fulfil its legal obligation to help the Government's Track and Trace policy, they are asked to register their visit by sending their name and the names of everybody in their party in an email to [ivisitedbbsc@gmail.com](mailto:ivisitedbbsc@gmail.com) Emails are deleted after 21 days.

If changing tents are in use please follow these guidelines:

- Wear face coverings while changing
- Keep talk to a minimum and change as quickly as possible

- Please do not leave any kit in the tent after you have changed but put it back in your car.

While the rule on gatherings of a maximum of six people does not apply to activity connected with the sailing, it does apply to socialising after sailing has finished and the Club has a legal obligation to ensure that this law is followed.

#### **Entering the series using Web Collect**

- Follow this link [Club Racing – Bough Beech Sailing Club \(boughbeechsc.org.uk\)](http://boughbeechsc.org.uk) and scroll to the bottom of the page.
- Log into Web Collect. This should take you to the Winter Handicap Championship page showing the dates of racing.
- To enter the whole Championship, tick the box for Race 1 (N.B it doesn't matter if you don't do that particular race and there is no need to specify which races you will be doing.) Select and click "Add to basket" and then "Checkout." If this takes you to "MY account/my details" screen click "save and proceed to checkout" again.
- On the next screen fill out the details of boat class, sail number and helm/crew names and click "Save"
- Go to "My basket" and click "checkout"
- Click "Place Order" and you should get an email confirming your entry.
