Club Winter Championship 2021:

Amendment 1 to Standard Club Sailing Instructions 2021/24

Para 2.1 of **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS** is amended to:

2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted only on the club website

Para 5.1 of **DECLARATIONS** is amended to:

5.1. Check-Out and Check-In:

- (a) There is no requirement for competitors to **sign on** before the start of each race or sequence of back-to-back races. However, they must have entered for the series by registering on Web Collect as given in the Notice of Race para 4.1
- (b) There is no requirement for competitors shall **sign off** after each day's racing.

Para 6.1 of **CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** is amended to:

6.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted only on the club website and will be made no later than 30 minutes before the start of the race to which it first applies, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 20.00hrs on the day before it will take place.

Para 8.1 of **CLASS FLAGS** is amended to:

8.1 The Conventional fleet will use Flag H for their warning signal; the Asymmetric fleet will use Flag F for theirs.

Para 18 of HEARING REQUESTS is amended as follows:

18.1. Protest forms are available at the race office, located on the first floor of the club house. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered to the race committee within the appropriate time limit. In addition, boats intending to protest are requested to notify the race committee on the committee boat upon finishing.

- 18.2. For each class the protest time limit is thirty minutes after the time the last boat in their class finishes. In the case of “back to back” races the protest time limit is thirty minutes after the time of the last boat finishes in the final race of the sequence of races.
- 18.3. The crew of boats intending to protest and boats protested must provide contacting details to the race committee so that the matter can be followed up remotely.
- 18.3. Unless otherwise stated, hearings will be held by Zoom at a time and date to be notified to competitors.
- 18.5. Breaches of SI's 21, 23, 24, and 25 will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a). Penalties for these breaches may be less than disqualification if the protest committee so decides. The scoring abbreviation for a “Discretionary Penalty Imposed” under this instruction will be DPI.
- 18.6. The protest committee may award discretionary penalties instead of disqualification. This changes RRS 64.2
