Combined Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

Subject only to minor amendment

This event will comprise a 5 race series for eSailors

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Virtual Racing Rules of Sailing dated 22nd January 2019

1.2 Rule infringements will be decided by the VR system and its decisions are final and are not appealable.

2. ENTRY

2.1 Entry is open to all Bough Beech Sailing Club members and Associated Members.

2.2 The Maximum number of competitors permitted by the VR system is 20. As the number of entries received by 13 April, a time limit set in a letter emailed to members, was less than 20, there will be no eliminating heats. Further entries may be made to the Sailing Secretary by emailing bsccomms@gmail.com before Thursday 24 April or until a total of 20 entries has been received, whichever is sooner.

2.3 Entrants must provide their name, email address and eSailing identity

2.4 Only entries received and acknowledged by the Sailing Secretary will be allowed to compete in the Club Championship.

3. SCHEDULE

3.1 The first race of the Club Championship will be held at 1400 hrs on Sunday 26 April. Competitors should ensure that they are logged on and ready to compete at that time. Subsequent races will be started once the preceding race has finished and the results noted.

3.2 There will be a total of 5 races.

3.3 The password for the series will be sent to competitors by email at least 24 hours before the start.

3.4 The winner of the event will be known as the Club Champion will participate in the Regional Championships Finals to be held and completed by 24th May 2020. The National Final for the 'Spring Club Championship' will be sailed on Saturday 30th May 2020.

3.5 In the event that the Club Champion is unable to compete in the regional and national series, the Club will be represented by the next best placed and available sailor.

4. EQUIPMENT

4.1 The equipment to be sailed will be the Day Boat racer.

4.2 The club champion must play in the regional & national final using the club's VIP account.

5. COURSE

5.1 The course will be "Upwind Medium" – a windward / leeward course with an offset mark and a downwind finish. TWO laps. The race target time will be 6 minutes. See diagram below.

6. SCORING

6.1 The Low Points Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

6.2 TWO discards can be taken in the FIVE races.

6.3 Ties will be broken in accordance with RRS A8.

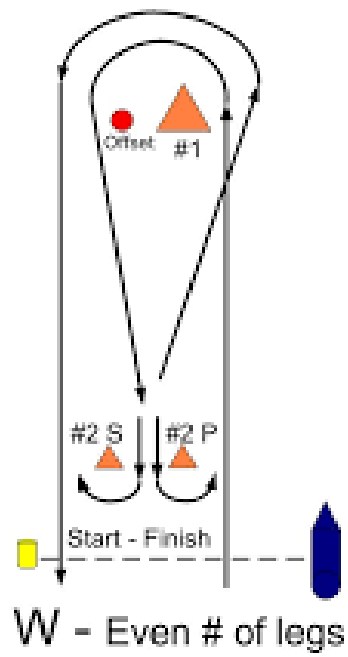
6.4 RRS A4.2 is changed such that a boat that did not start, did not finish, retired or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered for the series.

7. STARTING RACES Races shall be started by using the following signals.

1:15	P and Virtual Regatta flag	One	Warning Signal
1	P Removed	One	Preparatory Signal
0	Virtual Regatta flag removed	One	Starting Signal
