Bough Beech reservoir is situated in the Weald of Kent between Sevenoaks & Edenbridge.

1. Eligibility and Entry:

1.1 The event is open to all Dinghy Classes crewed by youth members of the Bough Beech Sailing Club who are under 20 yrs on September 12th 2019.

1.2 Entries will be accepted up to 10:30hrs on Saturday 10th September 2016 for those who wish to enter on the day.

2. Fees:

2.1 The event is free to all members of BBSC.

3. Rules

3.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020. The RYA prescriptions, the NOR and the sailing instructions.

3.2 In the event of any conflict between these rules, those of the club sailing instructions will prevail.

3.3 The exoneration penalty of the RYA disputes procedures will be available.

4. Schedule

4.1 A briefing will take place in the clubhouse at 1015hrs on 14th September.

5. Sailing instructions.

5.1 The sailing instructions are available on the club website.

6. Courses.

6.1 The course to be sailed will be defined and displayed on the club notice board and at the briefing.

7. Scoring.

7.1 The scoring system is as follows; ISAF low points scoring as in RRS (2014-2020) Appendix A4.

7.2 The number of races a boat may exclude from its score (or the number of races to count) will depend on the number of races completed, as follows:

8. Races lost to weather.

8.1 If a race is lost due to weather (or other unforeseen reason) the committee may display AP over H or a numeral pennant on the club mast.

9. Disclaimer of Liability:

9.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk..

9.2 The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during or after the event

10. Insurance:

10.1 Each Participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with minimum cover of £2 million per event, or the equivalent. Further more competitors are advised to consider the adequacy of their third party liability insurance,

11. Prizes

11.1 The BBSC organising committee have 3 cups to award in different age groups and a cup for 1st Lady. Other prizes will be awarded at the committees decision,

12. Personal safety

12.1 The wearing of wetsuits or dry suits maybe compulsory at the discretion of the organising authority on the day. Adequate personal bouyancy must be worn at all times afloat or on the pontoon.
