

Bough Beech SC - Road Map for recovery from Covid 19 restrictions

Date: 5 July 2020

Subject to revision in line with emerging Government advice. The stage at which Club action is set may go in either direction.

Stage 1	Government “lock down” restrictions: stay at home, no unnecessary travel, limited exercise allowed. Minimum contact outside family.
Stage 1A	As for Stage 1. Some travel restrictions. Limited exercise allowed. Social Distancing.
Stage 2	Individual Sailing only permitted. Club closed and inoperative. STAGE AS AT 13/05/20
Stage 3	Some relaxation of social distancing. Some club activities allowed with restrictions. Social distancing still in force EXPECTED FROM 02/08/20
Stage 4	Training courses may restart. Gatherings to 100+ people. Gyms and indoor sports permitted?
Stage 5	Normal operations. Major sports venues open. Music concerts. No restrictions for “vulnerable” people.
